Join herbalist Erin Piorier and Prairie enthusiast, planter and guardian, Donna Crocker at Donna's land in Western WI. This exquisite piece of property is nearly 30 acres and includes restored Long and Short Grass prairies as well as a medicine wheel garden and a tall grass prairie labyrinth. The Rush River, a trout stream, also runs through this property, offering a different habitat for water loving plants.

This day of workshops will include learning about the history and ecology of the prairie, prairie and river-side plant identification walks, medicine making and herbal medicine education. Experienced medicine makers will also have opportunities to harvest independently. Those new to herbal medicine will be guided through the process.

You will have a chance to see many native plants in their natural environment in the prairie or by the river including:
